



Introductory note

The year 2023 marks the 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Cyprus and Slovakia.

Over these thirty years, Cyprus and Slovakia have developed an excellent level of bilateral relations and have collaborated extensively within the context of the European Union and other international fora. The opening of the Embassy of Slovakia in Nicosia in 1993, and the respective opening of the Embassy of Cyprus in Bratislava in 2010, have further contributed to the development of the bonds of friendship and cooperation.

The principled stance of Slovakia, diachronically on the Cyprus issue, for a peaceful and just settlement according to the relevant UN Resolutions, as well as Slovakia's contribution in facilitating the bi-communal dialogue between Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot political parties for almost 35 years, along with its support to the Republic of Cyprus have always been highly appreciated.

Slovakia's major contribution to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP) spanning over two decades, has been of paramount importance for the successful carrying out of the Force's mission, as mandated by the UN Security Council resolutions as well as maintaining stability on the island.

To mark and pay tribute to the 30 years of diplomatic relations between Cyprus and Slovakia, a joint Exhibition and a Photo collection covering various areas of the longstanding relationship and friendship in the areas of politics, culture, diplomacy, as well as the engagement of Slovakia within the UNFICYP is being organized.

Building on the already strong bilateral ties, Cyprus and Slovakia look into the future with the aim to further develop and deepen the traditional excellent relationship based on common values, principles, and aspirations.





The 30th anniversary of diplomatic relations between the Republic of Cyprus and the Slovak Republic celebrated in 2023, provides an opportunity to take stock of the bonds of friendship and cooperation between the two countries and celebrate our common achievements of the past three decades. It is also a great opportunity to look ahead and set our common goals for the days to come.

Based on our shared values of democracy, human rights and the rule of law, and our common dedication to multilateralism and international law, and the enduring ties between our people, Cyprus and Slovakia have succeeded, since 1993, in forging a strong relationship of cooperation and friendship.

The opening of Slovakia's diplomatic mission in Nicosia in 1993 and Cyprus's diplomatic mission in Bratislava in 2010, have also played a significant role in bringing the two countries together and developing cooperation in various fields, such as culture, defense, education, and health to name a few. This cooperation has been further strengthened by the increased air connectivity between the two countries over the last years, especially in the fields of tourism and people-to-people contacts.

The principled stance of Slovakia over the years on the Cyprus issue, and its support for a just and viable settlement of the issue, in accordance with the agreed framework of a Bizonal Bi-communal Federation as prescribed in UN Resolutions, as well as providing its good offices fostering the bi-communal dialogue between Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot political parties have been highly valued. In addition, Slovakia's major contribution to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP) for over 20 years, has been of vital importance for the successful carrying out of the Force's mission, as mandated by the UN Security Council resolutions as well as maintaining stability on the island.

The Exhibition organised as well as the Photo Collection in this present booklet, offer an insight of the past 30 years of the excellent relationship between Cyprus and Slovakia that I hope will continue to flourish in the years to come.

The 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Slovak Republic and the Republic of Cyprus on 1st January 1993 is not just a celebration of three decades of fruitful cooperation between both countries in various fields, but also of close friendship and respect for each other we have cultivated over the years. A solid bond between two like-minded allies has developed and our relations have grown into a concrete partnership built on the fundaments of the EU and Eurozone membership, mutual solidarity and sharing of common values. Slovakia and Cyprus have achieved a lot together and certainly, there is a lot to be proud of.

On political level, our ties have been cemented by high-level dialogue, which culminated in the visit of the Slovak President, H.E. Zuzana Čaputová to Cyprus in December 2022. We have an excellent cooperation in many areas, however our biggest potential lies in innovations and modern technologies. Prestigious conference ReflectFest in Limassol, attended on yearly basis by thousands of startupists, innovators and investors, including hundreds of Slovaks, is the genuine project of two fellow graduates (Slovak and Cypriot one) from Oxford and at the same time the flagship of our economic and innovation diplomacy on the island.

Slovakia and Cyprus clearly subscribed to principles of a world order based on respect for rules and obligations under international law. The respect for the independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity of states is, in today's geopolitical and geoeconomical context of a particular importance to small states and peoples, such as Slovaks and Cypriots. Both countries have been actively promoting these principles in the world for decades and this commitment finds a very concrete, tangible and unique translation also in Cyprus.

Above mentioned is anchored in almost 35 years' worth of Slovak good offices offered for the Cyprus issue. The facilitation of the bi-communal dialogue of representatives of Greek-Cypriot and Turkish-Cypriot political parties represents a really exceptional factor in the relationship of two EU Member States. More than two decades long presence of a now truly robust Slovak contingent in UNFICYP with full responsibility for the sensitive Sector 4 of the buffer zone is in turn a manifestation of our contribution to security and stability on the island. The goal of such an involvement is obvious – to help bring about a solution to the Cyprus problem in line with the UN Security Council resolutions, principles of international law and EU values that is sustainable, just, and in favour of all Cypriots.

The beautiful island of Cyprus, is not only one of the most favorite holiday destination of Slovak tourists, but at the same time place of work and home to many more Slovaks, including a significant group of mixed Slovak-Cypriot marriages well integrated into the local society. All these individuals and families contribute to the socio-economic development of the island, but also to the enhancement of people-to-people contacts, thus mutual understanding and friendship of both nations.

This unique publication and panel exhibition represent a captivating celebration of past three decades of friendly bilateral ties between Slovakia a Cyprus in various fields. In the upcoming period let us work through common endeavours on their further development to the benefit of cooperation, peace, stability and prosperity of the great people of both countries.

BRATISLAVA, June 19, (WEBNOVINY) — Slovak Foreign Affairs Minister Miroslav Lajcak, who is on an official visit to Cyprus, assured Cypriot officials on Tuesday that Slovak soldiers in UN peace-keeping units will not be withdraw from the island. There are currently 159 Slovak troops in the UNFICYP peacekeeping mission that has been operating there since 2001. In Cyprus, Lajcak met with Foreign Minister Erato Kozakou-Marcoullis, President Demetris Christofias, and with the Mayor of Nicosia

Constantinos Yiorkadiis, Cypriot officials appreciated the long-term role of Slovak diplomacy in the dialogue between the Greek Cypriot and Turkish-Cypriot communities and the role of Slovak troops in the UNFICYP mission. The mission is to prevent renewed fighting between the Cypriot Greeks and Turks, to ensure compliance with the ceasefire between the warring parties and help to restore and maintain law and order on the island. "The head of Slovak diplomacy assured them that the Slovak side will continue in these activities," the ministry's press department informed media. Both parties also declared their interest in further deepening of Slovak-Cypriot relations in all areas.

Slovak-Cypriot relations in all areas Lajcak pointed out that in the interest of both parties it is neces-sary to complete the necessary contractual-legal base, where he specifically mentioned the absence of an agreement on avoiding double taxation

Lajcak and the Cypriot partners paid considerable attention to the post-election situation in Greece. Both sides appreciated that the Greek voters favored particularly pro-European parties, which is the basis for maintaining stability in the euro area. "We consider the project of the euro very important and successful, which brings convenience to our citizens. We therefore care to preserve and enhance stability in the euro area," said

Laicak. He informed his partners of the intention of the Slovak Parliament to ratify the ESM and highlighted the solidarity exempli-fied by this mechanism. "This step again shows the responsibility and strength of the European Union," he concluded
